Why take a DGP course at Harlaxton?

How many people will be in my cohort?

A Designing your Global Path cohort will be between 15-20 students. These students are from around the world and all over the United States. You will have all Manor events with other programs and then special programming with your cohort. Your fellow classmates will become lifelong friends and integral in your learning experience.

What students are eligible for DGP?

Anyone who is a high school graduate is eligible to take part in the Designing your Global Path. We are looking for motivated students who want to take a deep dive into their passions, strengths and think deeply about their future and global connections it can have. DGP candidates interview for a place on the program and are selected for qualities that we see will make the most of their time abroad and in the program.

How far in Harlaxton from London?

Harlaxton is just a train ride away from London! In just over an hour you will be in a world capital with the world at your fingertips. From world class museums, restaurants, and tourist sites, our students can be immersed in the UK and discover the home of punk rock, the Queen, and the tube!

Is there a train station close to Harlaxton?

Yes, the closest station is in Grantham and our shuttle bus goes there. The train has direct service to London and Edinburgh. Travel to York, Leeds, Nottingham, Liverpool, and Lincoln are also very easy day trips on the train.

What is the nearest town? What is there?

Our closest town is Grantham, population 35,000. The town has everything our students need including grocery stores, cafes, pharmacies, a hospital, shopping, movie theatres, and other amenities. Shuttles run Monday- Friday and Sunday transport is available for students wishing to attend church services.

Do I live and study at the Manor?

Yes, students live and study on our campus. Student rooms include a single bed, wardrobe and desk. Most student rooms are doubles and have bathrooms and showers in the hallways. Students may live in the Manor or in the Carriage House, which is a two-minute walk to the Manor. All bedding is supplied, as well as a towel.

Classrooms are fully equipped and in the Manor. Some are modern study spaces and others are our beautiful staterooms. The Manor and Carriage House have WIFI throughout and computer labs. Most student bring their own laptops.

What services does the Manor have?

The Manor has everything a student needs right on campus! Your meals are served in our refectory, we have a student services area, an onsite nurse, a counselor in the evenings, student study areas, a sports hall, sports fields, 24 hour reception/ security, mailboxes, a small shop, bookstore services, and shuttle services.

Can my family and friends come to visit?

Of course, they can! Harlaxton has a family weekend where we have planned activities as well as the option for friends and family to rent rooms with us as we have availability. Many students have a visit throughout their time at the Manor. We love to welcome your friends and family to our beautiful location.
